Results will be announced during the rules meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday before the Wayne County Fair officially begins. Age determination for Junior or Senior is as of January 1, 2011.

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

1. Test

80% of all test questions will be taken from the 4-H Horse Science and Horsemanship books and could consist of true / false, matching, multiple choice or fill in the blank. The remaining 20% will be from the Michigan State University website <http://web1.msue.msu.edu/cyf/youth/>.

2. Interview

Interviewee will be judged on appearance (interview attire), self presentation, the ability to give a brief overview of their 4-H experience, and will be asked to answer one “pop question” from the judges.

3. Junior Executive Board Meeting

As a program participant, you must attend at least one Junior Executive Board meeting. Meetings will be held at 6:00 p.m. prior to the WCHP meetings for June and July. Be sure to sign the sign-in sheet!

4. Performance

Contestants will compete in three classes in their respective age groups at Learner’s Day (be sure to register your classes on the Learner’s Day Registration form). Results will be held until awards are presented at the Wayne County Fair. Contestants must show their 2011 WCHP registered horse or pony project.
