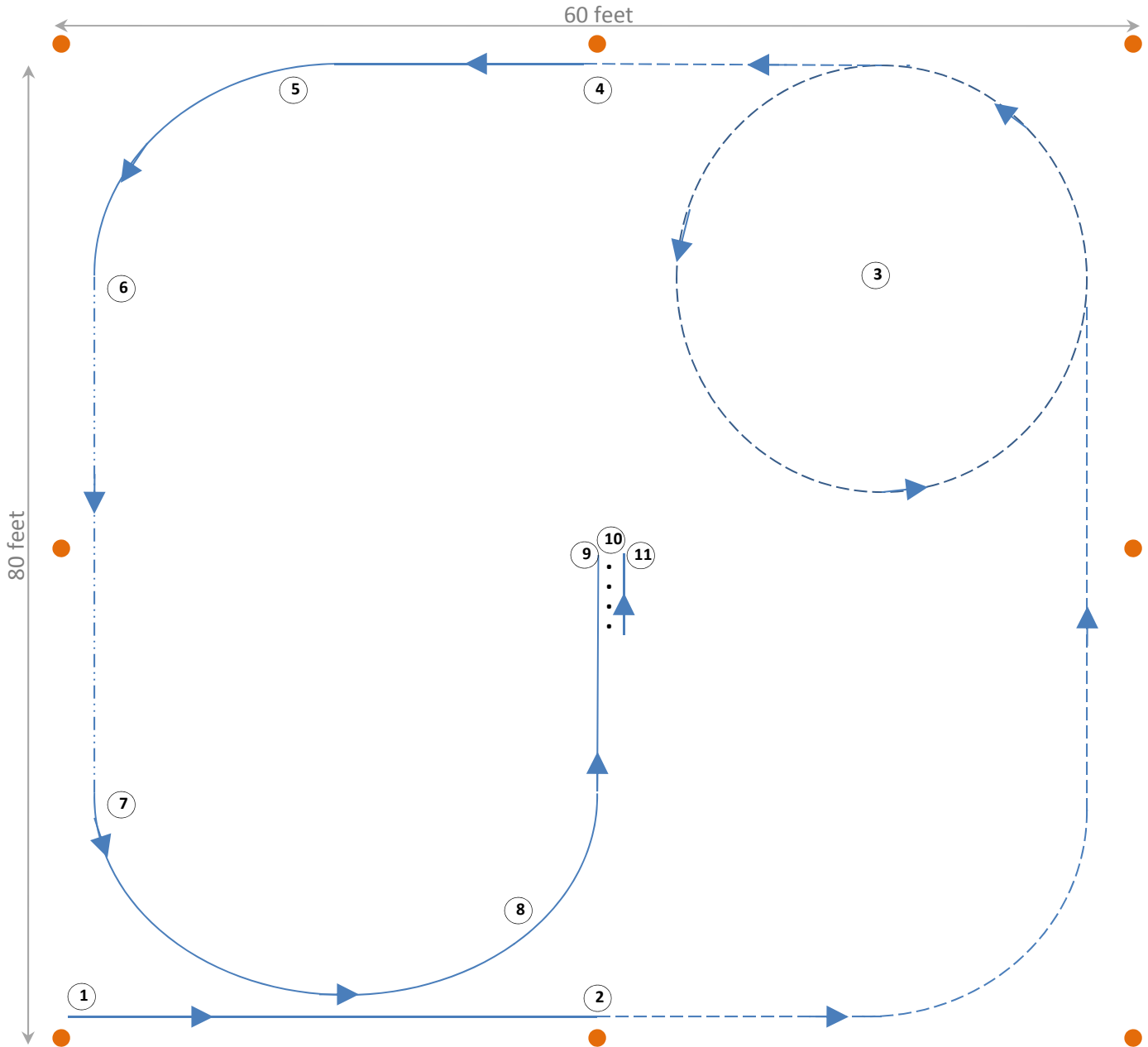

1	Enter at walk	Quality of walk; straightness			
2	Begin jog or trot	Transition at cone; Quality of transition			
3	Circle left	Quality of trot; roundness of circle			
4	Break to walk	Transition at cone; Quality of transition			
5	Turn left	Quality of steering			
6	Begin Lope/Canter on Left lead	Quality of transition, correct lead, control of canter, straightness of line			
7	Break to walk, turn left	Quality of transition, control of steering			
8	Turn left down center line	Quality of steering, accuracy on center line			
9	Halt at center	Quality of Halt, Straightness on center line			
10	Back 3 to 5 Steps	Quality of back			
11	Return to center and Stand for inspection	Quality of return and stand			
	Rider's position and seat	Correctness and effect of the aids
